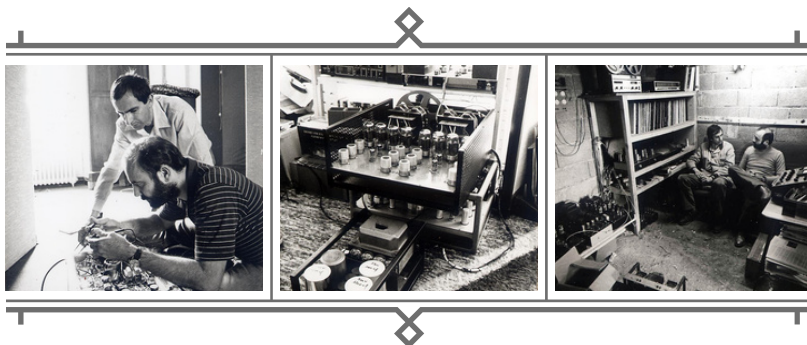

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Installation and Start-Up Instructions

Jadis DA88S

Amplifier Installation

Each integrated amplifier is supplied with its tubes, mains power cable and remote control (battery reference: CR2032 or LR03 AAA depending on the model).

Please do not throw away the packaging as it will be need to re-pack the unit for maintenance. The warranty will be deemed void if the appliance is not properly packed.

Place your JADIS amplifier on a flat, stable, and heat-resistant surface.

Please avoid:

- Placing the unit directly on a carpet or any flammable material;
- Positioning objects on top of the amplifier, in order to ensure optimal ventilation;
- Placing any container filled with water or other liquids near the unit, to prevent potential damage.

Ventilation and Heat Management

As a vacuum tube amplifier, your JADIS unit naturally generates heat during operation. It is essential to provide adequate open space around the amplifier to ensure proper heat dissipation.

Recommendations:

- Do not use a fan to accelerate the cooling process;
- Avoid direct exposure to draughts, as sudden temperature changes may weaken the tubes and cause microfractures;
- Do not move the amplifier while the tubes are still hot.

Electrical Connection

Ensure that your JADIS amplifier is connected to a compliant electrical installation with a proper earth (ground) connection to guarantee safe operation.

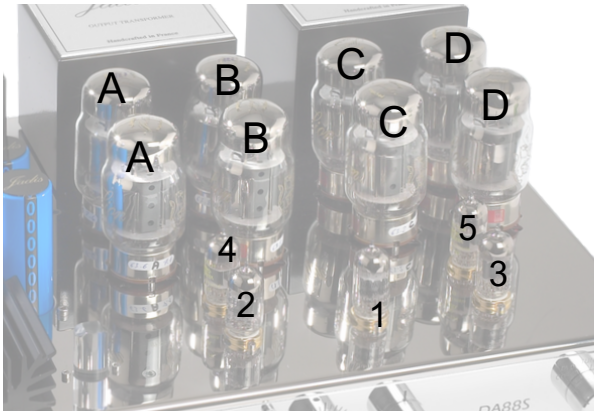
To ensure the longevity and reliability of your amplifier:

- Operate the ON/OFF switch with a firm and decisive action;
- Use only the ON/OFF switch to power the unit on or off;
- Never disconnect the mains power cord to shut down the amplifier.

Before carrying out any intervention, such as replacing a cable or modifying a connection, make sure that the amplifier has been switched off for at least five minutes.

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Tube Layout



This document is intended exclusively for qualified technicians.

Installation, commissioning, and maintenance operations must be carried out only by authorized personnel who have received appropriate training and are familiar with the specific requirements of this type of equipment.

A, B, C, D (x2) : Power Tubes

1, 2 & 3: ECC82 /12AU7

4 & 5 : ECC83 / 12AX7

Before handling the amplifier, ensure that it is completely switched off and disconnected from the mains power supply.

Then remove the protective tube cage.

Tube Installation

Each DA88S amplifier is supplied with a matched and tested set of tubes.

Recommendations:

- Do not mix the tubes;
- Install them immediately after unpacking, following their original designated positions.

Installation Precautions

During installation:

- Never apply excessive force when inserting tubes, as this may damage the tube sockets;
- Ensure the correct orientation of the power tubes (A, B, C, and D), which are fitted with locating pins at the center of their base to prevent incorrect installation.

Final Safety Check

Once all tubes have been installed, refit the protective tube cage.

⚠ Important: The protective tube cage must never be removed while the amplifier is connected to the mains power supply, whether the unit is switched on or off.

Front Panel Description



On the front panel of the unit, you will find the following controls and indicators:

ON/OFF Power Switch: Used to switch the amplifier on and off.

OPERATE/STANDBY switch: Stand- By : Preheat before high-voltage, mute switch
/ Operate :Applies the high voltage to the tubes.

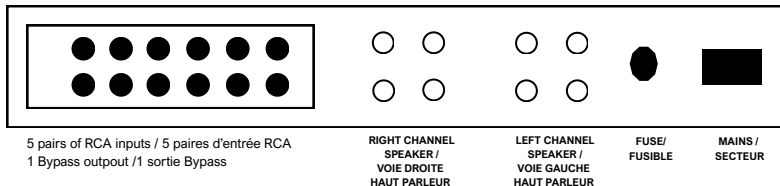
LED Indicator:The power LED illuminates green when the unit is in operation.

Volume Control:Adjusts the overall listening level.

Balance Control:Adjusts the sound balance between left and right channel.

Input Selector:Allows you to select the desired audio source input.

Rear Panel Description



The following connections and features are located on the rear panel of the unit:

RCA Input/Output:

5 pairs of RCA

1 Bypass output

Speaker Terminals:

Two pairs of output connectors (bi-wiring) for each channel for connection to the loudspeakers while respecting the recommended polarity and impedance requirements.

Mains Fuse:

To protect the unit against overcurrent conditions, electrical & power supply faults.

Fuse value: 8A for 230V - 10A for 110V.

Mains Power Connector:

Used to connect the amplifier to the AC power supply

How to turn on your amplifier

Before turning on the power, make sure the unit is set to OFF, STANDBY/ OPERATE switch on STANDBY position and the volume is at the minimum level, then connect the speakers, the sources (RCA), and the power cord.

For use:

Turn on the amplifier using the ON/OFF switch. Always turn the volume down to the minimum before switching sources. Wait a few minutes, flip the OPERATE / STANDBY switch to OPERATE, and start listening. Reverse the steps to switch off.

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Matching the Amplifier to Your Loudspeakers

The load impedance of your JADIS amplifier is factory-configured for use with loudspeakers rated between 4 and 8 ohms. Other adjustments are possible by internal settings.

This amplifier inverts the absolute phase between the input and output.

Cleaning your amplifier

To clean your amplifier (The device has been switched off for 30 minutes): Wipe the stainless steel parts with a soft cloth dampened with a non-abrasive cleaner. Avoid using any products on the gold-plated surfaces; dry cleaning only.

Maintenance

Your Jadis amplifier is preset for your country's voltage. If a malfunction occurs:

- Turn off the device immediately.
- Unplug all cables, including the power cord.
- Do not open the device and contact your Jadis dealer for diagnostic and repair.
